I have been advised and understand that my presence in the elections vehicle subjects me to risk of personal harm due to the nature of being in a motor vehicle during the course of the elections officials duty.

In consideration of the permission by the Elections Department to accompany an elections official while on duty, I hereby agree to follow all departmental rules and regulations applicable to civilian participants in the ride along program, and I further agree not to make any claim against, sue or hold financially or legally responsible in any way the San Benito County Elections Department, or any employee thereof, for, or based upon any injury to my person, however sustained, while I am a passenger in the elections vehicle.

General Rules & Guidelines

- Ride alongs are scheduled for up to 3 hours and coincide with morning and afternoon shifts.
- Please arrive to your scheduled ride along on time, if you are not present at the scheduled time your ride along may be cancelled.
- Participants must be at least 16 years old.
- Only one ride along permitted per election.
- Participants must wear appropriate business casual attire which is suitable for having public contact.
- Clothing that displays information that advocates for or against any candidate or measure on the ballot is not permissible.
- Participants are observers and you are not to become involved in any incident, conversation, or altercation between election employees and the public.
- You are expected to conduct yourself in a civil, personable, and courteous manner.
- You may use a telephone or handheld recording device while you are on a ride along.
- You may not carry or use any weapon while you are on a ride along.
