The office of the City Clerk in San Juan Bautista is currently an elective position. That is, the voters elect a City Clerk. If the position becomes vacant, the City Council can either appoint a City Clerk to fill the remaining term of the position, or, can call for a special election to elect a new City Clerk to fill the remaining term of the position.

The ballot measure would change the City Clerk from an elective position to an appointive position. The City Clerk would be appointed by the City Council. If the position became vacant, the City Council would appoint someone to fill out the remaining term of the position. The appointed City Clerk would serve at the pleasure of the City Council who could delegate that authority to the City Manager.

A "Yes" vote on the measure would approve the change to an appointive position. A "No" vote on the measure would retain the position as elective.
