Response to the filed Petition for Local Recall on Monday, June 30, 2025

Dear Heidi,

This letter is to respond to the filed Petition for Local Recall on Monday, June 30, 2025, for Supervisor Kollin Kosmicki.

The public examination period for this Petition is from Monday, June 30, 2025, to Thursday, July 10, 2025. During this time, a voter of the applicable electoral jurisdiction or the elections official may seek a writ of mandate or injunction requiring any or all of the statement of the proponents or the answer of the officer included with the petition to be amended or deleted. Such a request must be filed no later than the end of the 10-day public examination period, Thursday, July 10, 2025. A peremptory writ of mandate or injunction will only be issued upon clear and convincing proof that the material in question is false, misleading, or inconsistent with the requirements of the Elections Code § 11042.5.

**This Petition is rejected by the County of San Benito Elections Department on Tuesday, July 1, 2025, due to the error below.** This error is found to be incorrect according to the California Office of the Secretary of State document titled "Procedures for Recalling State and Local Officials" and applicable California Election Code.

- The one of the listed proponents' names is misspelled, Annie Brandford should be Annie Bradford,

Pursuant to California Elections Code §11042, when a proposed recall petition format is deemed insufficient, proponents have 10 calendar days from the date of the official notice of rejection to correct the deficiencies and submit a revised version. As the petition format was officially rejected on July 1, 2025, the 10-day deadline is on July 11, 2025. However, the revised version may be submitted any day before July 11th. Therefore, we will accept resubmission of the edited Petition from today to Friday, July 11, 2025.

To proceed with the recall process for Supervisor Kollin Kosmicki, you will need to correct the errors outlined above and resubmit the Petition for Local Recall. Please

ensure that all revisions strictly adhere to the guidelines provided in the California Office of the Secretary of State's "Procedures for Recalling State and Local Officials" and the applicable California Election Code.

We strongly recommend thoroughly reviewing the attached petition with comments and Exhibit E3: Sample Petition for Local Recall with highlights to ensure all necessary edits are made accurately. Adherence to these regulations is crucial for the successful processing of your petition.

Once all corrections have been made, please resubmit the revised Petition for Local Recall to the County of San Benito Elections Department. If you have any further questions or require additional clarification on the required edits, do not hesitate to contact our office at 831-636-4016.
