- 2) It significantly WORSENS growth by forcing the CRUSH of NEW HOUSING and TRAFFIC GROWTH into two places: Hollister and San Juan Bautista, radically WORSENING TRAFFIC on HWY25.
- 3) Its rules will DEVASTATE our lifeblood agricultural economy by starving local infrastructure of needed funding. It's STRONGLY OPPOSED by San Benito's local farmers and ranchers.
- 4) It DIVERTS millions in San Benito's sales tax revenues for road improvements to surrounding counties.

PORC's Measure Q devastates local agriculture, allows unchecked housing and traffic growth in Hollister and San Juan Bautista, and costs San Benito County \$30 million per year through 2050. Our quality of life will suffer without funds to address decaying congested roads, crowded schools and public safety.
