CITY ATTORNEY'S IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS OF ADVISORY MEASURE T
RECOMMENDING THAT THE CITY OF HOLLISTER
INDEPENDENCE DAY RALLY BE CONDUCTED ANNUALLY
OVER THE FOURTH OF JULY WEEKEND**

On June 6, 2022, the City Council voted to place Advisory Measure T on the November 8, 2022 general municipal election ballot. Advisory Measure T is for advisory purposes only and will not in any manner amend current City law.

If enacted by a majority of Hollister voters, this Advisory Measure would advise the City Council that the voters desire to hold the City of Hollister Independence Day Rally annually over the Fourth of July weekend.

A "yes" vote on Advisory Measure T will recommend that the City of Hollister Independence Day Rally be held annually over the Fourth of July weekend.

A "no" vote on Advisory Measure T will not recommend that the City of Hollister Independence Day Rally be held annually over the Fourth of July weekend.
